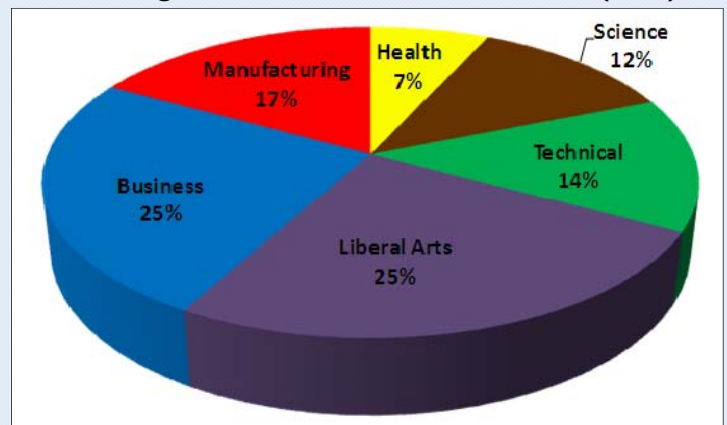

Knowledge Distribution of Workforce Skills (2012)



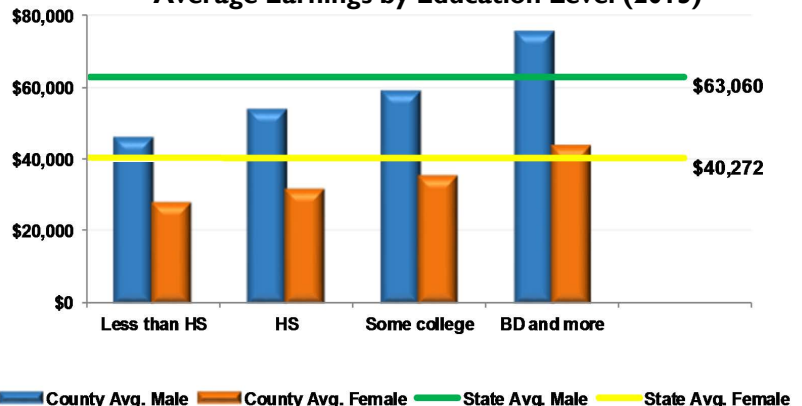

Of employed Henderson County residents, 51% are out-commuters.



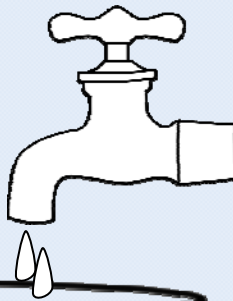
In-Commuters: Individuals living outside Henderson County who are employed inside Henderson County.

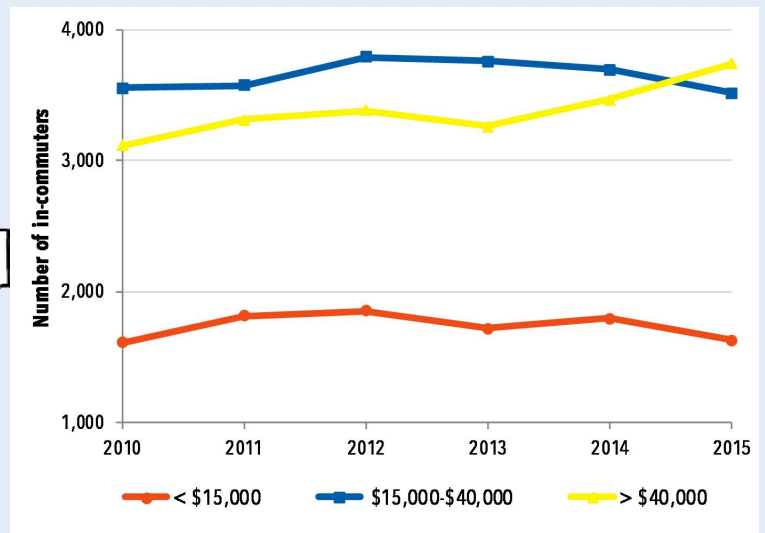

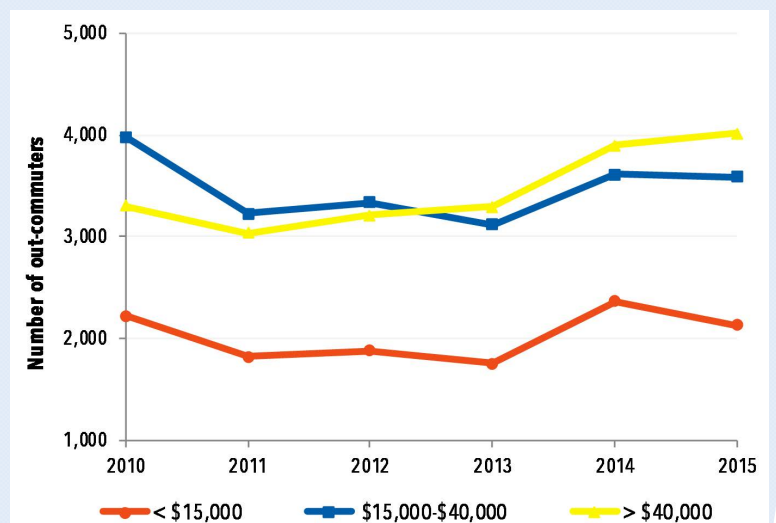
In-Commuters by Average Annual Earnings (2010-2015)
