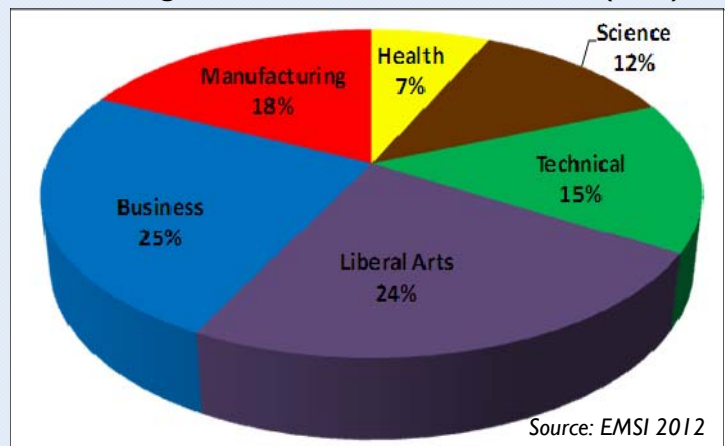

### Knowledge Distribution of Workforce Skills (2012)



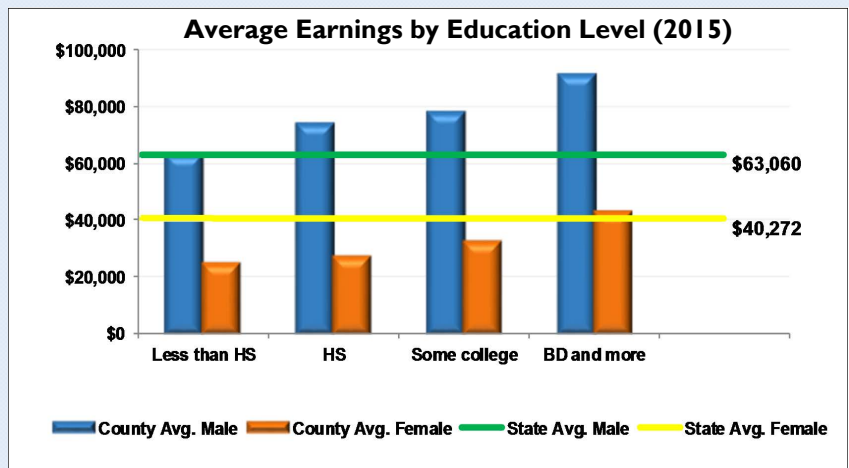

**In-Commuters:** Individuals living outside Webster County who are employed inside Webster County.

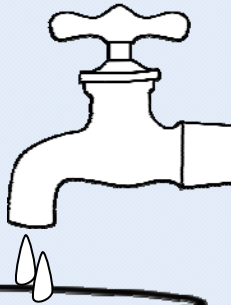
**Out-Commuters:** Individuals living in Webster County who are employed outside Webster County.

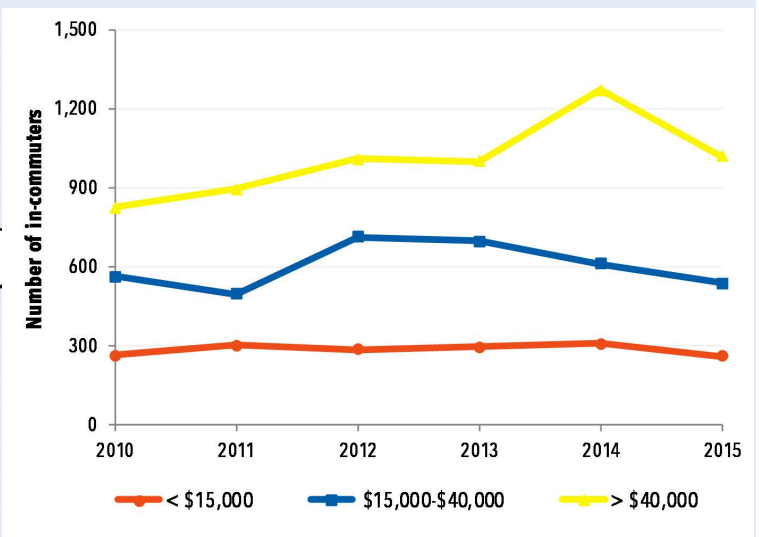

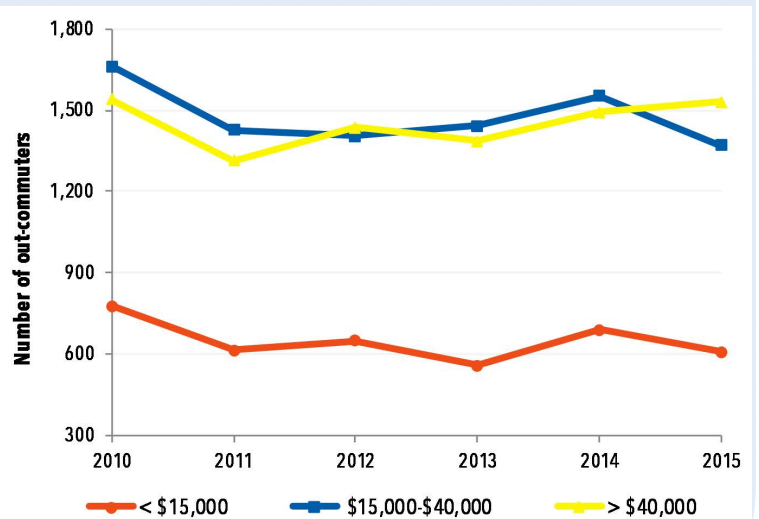
### In-Commuters by Average Annual Earnings (2010-2015)
